Location

Liverpool, Our Lady and St Nicholas Pierhead, 5 Old Churchyard, Liverpool L2 8GW.

Draw

Each team is required to submit their team entry prior to the draw. The draw will start at 11am and clergy will welcome everyone and proceed with the draw. The same as last year you get the chance to choose your place in the running order of the competition. Bands will be entered into a draw and will be able to choose their time slot on the day.

Test piece

Each team has a 30 minute slot in which to complete their test piece and are required to be at the bottom of tower 15 minutes prior to ringing. The first band will start ring at 11.30. On average the test piece takes 14 minutes and is a 220 of Grandsire Cinques. The competition piece is indicated with two whole pulls on 1-2.

Hawkear

This year the competition will not be using Hawkear

Judge

Peter Hughes from York will be chief judge, and assistant judges Alice Etherington and Simon Percy.

Food and Drink

Tea, Coffee, and light refreshments will be available on arrival. The Bar will open at 12 noon when Lunches will also be available. All food and drink will be provide be the local ringers inside the church. As the local ringers are providing helpers and organising food and beer you are encouraged to use this facility.
